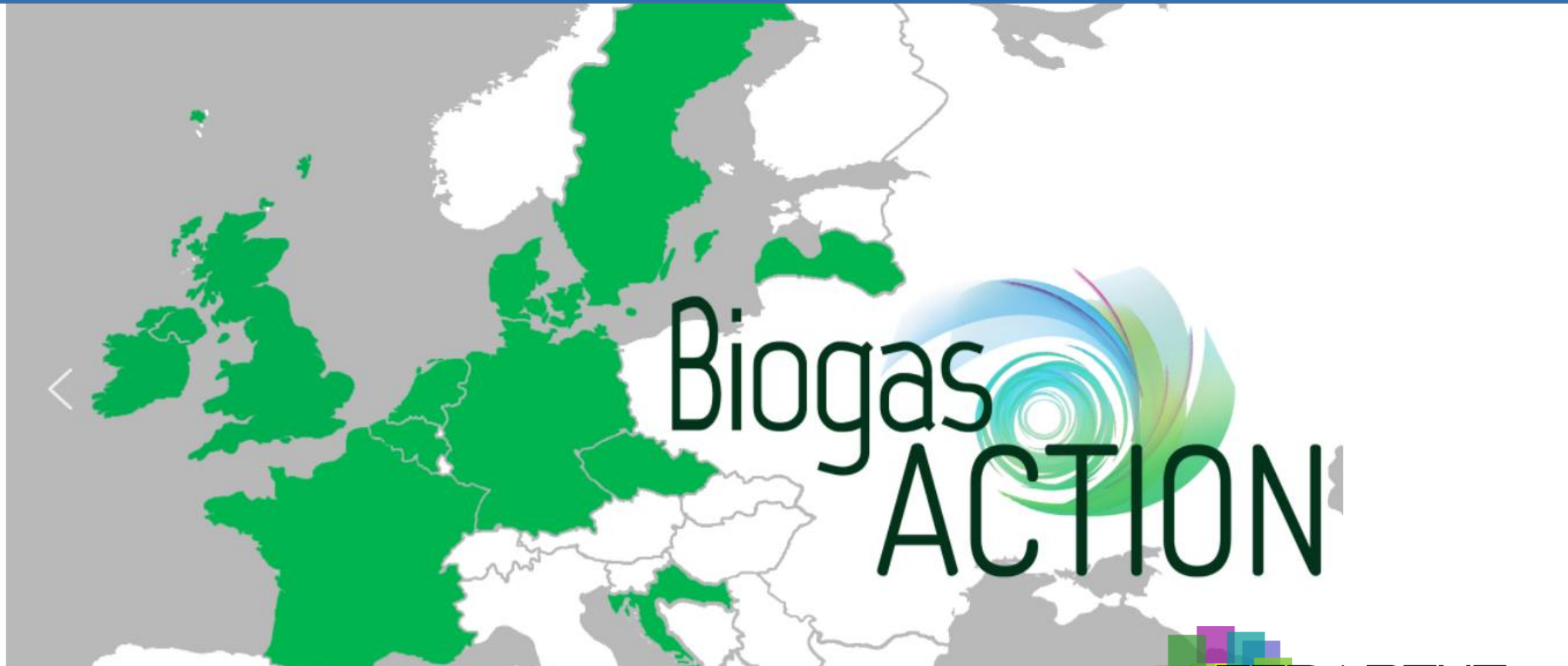

The BiogasAction Intervention Regions

5 types of strategic actions in 9 target regions

1. **Institutional-building** – Stakeholder mobilisation & engagement
2. **Strengthening the biogas sector framework** – Improvement of frameworks supporting the development of biogas
3. **Optimising business models and financing of biogas projects** – Identify, make the feasibility and exploit business models
4. **Optimizing biogas production** - Building capacities and competences for plant operators, farmers, waste producers...
5. **Assistance to specific high quality biogas project development** - Practical project development assistance
